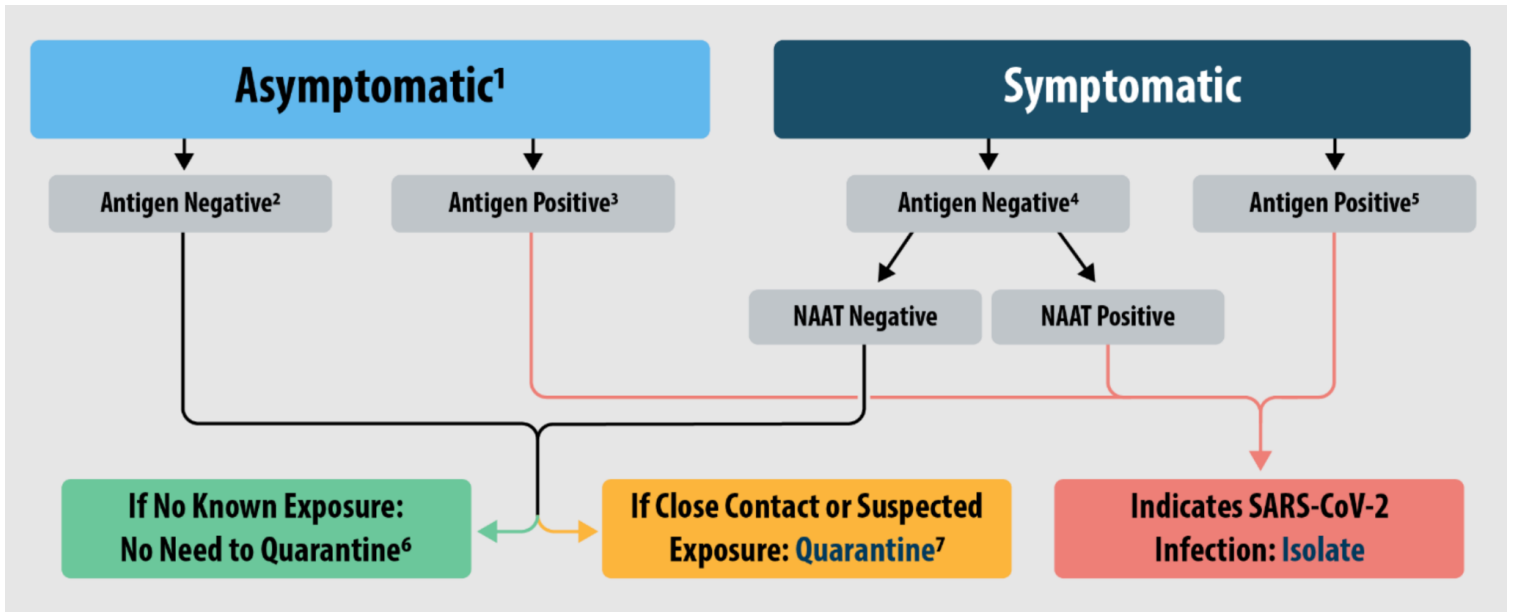


## Rapid Antigen Testing Flowchart



### Definitions:

Low Likelihood - No close contact in the last 10 days OR up to date on vaccinations per CDC OR positive COVID test in the last 90 days.

High Likelihood - Close contact in the last 10 days AND not up to date on vaccinations per CDC AND no COVID-19 in the last 90 days.

### Notes - Refer to numbers in the chart above:

- 1 - Asymptomatic people who have had a SARS-CoV-2 infection in the last 90 days should follow CDC's guidance on testing for those within 90 days of their initial infection.
- 2 - If High Likelihood, confirm negative with PCR/NAAT test.
- 3 - If Low Likelihood, confirm positive result with PCR/NAAT test.
- 4 - If Low Likelihood, no confirmation with PCR/NAAT test is needed.
- 5 - If Low Likelihood, consider confirmation with PCR/NAAT test.
